

SPELLER'S CHOICE

You must do one speller's choice activity each night in order to prepare for your spelling test on Friday. Turn your homework sheet over. Draw a line down the middle of your sheet hot dog style. Now do the same thing hamburger style. Now you have 4 boxes. You can use these boxes for your Speller's Choice activities. Please write the NAME of the activity at the top of the box and then complete the activity.

You may choose any **FOUR** of the following activities.

****Please choose a different activity each night!****

1. **ABC Order**- Write your words in alphabetical order.
2. **Rainbow words**- Use three different colors to write your words.
3. **Cheer your words**- Pretend you are a cheerleader and cheer out your words (and spell them too!) to an adult. Write this in the box as your choice and have someone sign their name to say they listened to you cheer your words!
4. **Backward words**- Write your words forwards, then backwards!
5. **Pyramid words**- Write your words adding one letter at a time.
The result will be a pyramid of words!

Example: star

s

st

sta

star

6. **Spelling City-** Go to the website <http://www.spellingcity.com> and select "Find a List". Type in your teachers name- Laura McGee. Then, select the unit and week that we are working on. You can do two **DIFFERENT** activities each week from Spelling City. Write this in the box as your choice and have someone sign it to say that you did your words on Spelling City. Be sure you check the list and practice with the right one!
7. **Disappearing words-** Write each word, then write it again but leave one letter out...then write it again and leave TWO letters out...then three..until your word has disappeared!

Example: cowboy

Cowboy -owboy --wboy ---boy ----oy -----y -----

8. **Computer fun-** Use your computer to type your words. Use different fonts and make it look really fun! Be sure you print it out and bring it in your FROG binder in your spelling folder with you homework sheet! Or you can type your words in an e-mail to me too, if you want~ laura.mcgee@carteretk12.org
9. **Friendly Words-** Write two words that share a letter so they are touching!

Example: m
cat
n

10. **Other Handed-** If you are right handed, write your words with your left hand! If you are left handed, write your words with your right hand!
