\* The performance composite is currently defined as the proficiency rates on all EOCs taken plus the proficiency rates on the Grade 10 writing test.

### Notes:

1. When reviewing the results history for a single high school, comparisons of the proficiency composite from year to year are only minimally valid. The changing numbers of EOC courses being tested, the revision of the various tests for EOC subjects, and the alteration of proficiency cut scores in various tests have caused variations in the foundational data to such an extent that a direct comparison of any two years is almost impossible.
2. When using the performance composite to review high school performance over time, the best results come from a comparison of one school to others in individual years and determining changes in those relationships.
