This holiday classic, takes students on a spectacular journey exploring dances inspired by other cultures. Appropriate for grades K-12, students are sure to enjoy the colorful sets, intricate costumes and engaging story.

This program offers remediation and enrichment within the parameters of the NC Dept of Education curriculum in Dance, Music and Theater, and Common Core Standards in English Language Arts with a focus on character studies that falls within the following standards:

NCRL 2.2 (also 3.2, 4.2, and 5.2) - recount stories, including fables and folktales from diverse cultures and determine their central message/lesson moral

NCRL 2.3 (also 3.3, 4.3, and 5.3) - describe how characters in a story respond to major events and challenges

NCRL 4.7 - make connections between the text of a story and visual presentation, identify where each version reflects specific descriptions and directions in text

NCRL 5.5 - explain how scenes provide overall structure to a particular drama
